Sakurako Matsushima attended Tokyo University of the Arts and is today Professor at Utsunomiya University in Tochigi Prefecture, and Director of the Asian Lacquer Craft Exchange Project, <<https://asian-urushi.com/>>. She has exhibited her works worldwide since 1989. These range from sculptures to large, wearable body ornaments and delicate wall installations. These are the range of her artistry; beginning with bamboo or lacquered hemp cloth (*kanshitsu*) substrate, then incorporates highly sophisticated decorative techniques such as *makie* and *shell inlay*.
